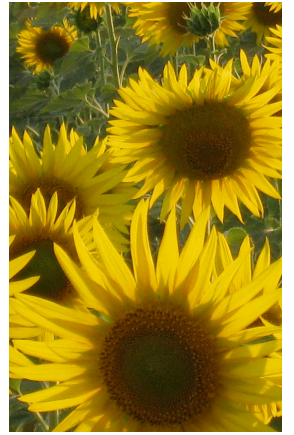
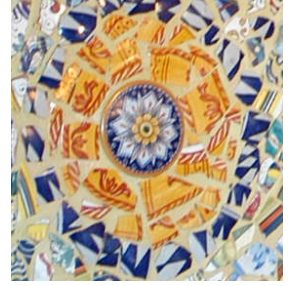


Poggio del Vento
